

MCCU Member Match program donates funds

Monroe Community Credit Union recently presented donations totaling almost \$2,500 to three local nonprofit organizations from its second quarter Member Match program.

Member Match began in 2022 and allows MCCU members to choose from three nonprofit organizations each quarter. For every new membership opened at MCCU, the credit union matches the initial \$5 deposit required to join and donates the funds on behalf of the new member to a local nonprofit organization.

Since it began the Member Match program has benefited 18 local nonprofit organizations.
